



Let's Learn About Careers in Law!



Presentation



<p>Description</p>	<p>The goal of this activity is to familiarize students with various careers in law. A quiz asks students to guess the profession using as few clues as possible.</p> <p>To prepare, students can consult the “Legal Careers” section on the Éducaloi website: educaloi.qc.ca/en/categories/legal-careers/</p>
<p>Objectives</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discover careers related to the law • Learn about the training and duties for each profession
<p>Geared Toward</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school students • Personal Orientation Project classes
<p>Suggested Length</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 60 minutes (15 minutes preparation/45 minutes for activity)
<p>Material</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PowerPoint presentation: Let’s Learn About Careers in Law! • Scoresheet (attached) • Computer, projector, screen
<p>Preparation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Print the scoresheet. • Read through the presentation, including all Teacher’s Notes, in advance. • Divide students into teams for the quiz. We suggest making four teams. • Place the teams in separate parts of the room.

Activity

Goal

Students must try to guess the correct profession using as few clues as possible. The team gets 4 points if they only need 1 clue, 3 points if they need 2 clues, 2 points if they need 3 clues, and 1 point if they need all 4 clues.

The team with the most points wins.

- 1 Explain** to the students.
(10 minutes)
- 2 Divide** students into teams.
(5 minutes)
- 3 Present** the various careers in law, beginning with the three illustrations. Simply click on the number of the profession you want to explore to bring up that slide.
(15 minutes)
- 4 Lead the quiz.** For each “**Who am I?**” question, click anywhere on the slide to bring up the next clue. Since the goal is to guess the profession using as few clues as possible, be sure to only bring up one clue at a time. As you go along, **fill out the scoresheet** by entering the correct number of points for the number of clues the teams needed.
(25 minutes)
- 5 Announce** the winning team and wrap up the activity.
(5 minutes)
